FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT – CALL FOR PAPERS JUNE 13 -17, 2006 – HEC Montreal, Canada

The 2006 Meeting of the Psychometric Society, the 71st Annual meeting, will be held in Montreal, Canada on the campus of HEC Montreal.

Pre-conference workshops will be held on Tuesday, June 13th, with the main conference running from Wednesday to Saturday, June 14 - 17.

Persons wishing to present talks (contributing sessions or poster sessions) should send titles and abstracts of no more than 200 words. Abstracts should be e-mailed to "**pmetrika@uncg.edu**". The subject header of the e-mail should include reference to the 2006 IMPS.

The attached file should be in text format

(.doc, .rtf, .txt).

References should not be included with abstracts.

The following information should be included in attachment:

- › **Name, institutional affiliation, mailing address, and e-mail address for each author**
- › **Name of the presenter of the submission**
- › **Type of submission**
(Contributing or Poster session)
- › **Title of submission**
- › **Topic area of submission**

- › **Abstract** (<200 words)

Each person is permitted to present at most one contributed paper. This restriction does not prevent a keynote speaker or an invited speaker from also presenting one contributed paper, nor does it limit the number of papers on which one can be listed as a coauthor.

In 2003 the Society's journal, *Psychometrika*, started a new section on application-oriented papers that highlight the essential connection between psychometric methodology and its application to behavioral data analysis. In keeping with this new tradition, submissions of application-oriented papers from the areas of business administration and the various fields in the social and behavioral sciences are strongly encouraged.

The deadline for abstract submission is **February 20, 2006**. Authors will be notified by February 28th whether their presentation is accepted.

Reduced payment will be possible until May 1st. Workshops start June 13th conference starts June 14th.
