

## Psychometrician

The National Board of Osteopathic Medical Examiners (NBOME) is seeking applicants for a full time position of **psychometrician**. The NBOME develops computer-delivered licensing examinations for the osteopathic physicians in the U.S., osteopathic medical subject examinations, and osteopathic specialty examinations.

The main responsibilities of psychometrician include standard setting, item analysis, equating, and reporting for the computer-delivered licensing examinations; designing, conducting, and coordinating research projects. Psychometrician is strongly encouraged to initiate applied psychometric research studies intended for professional presentation and publication.

The candidates should have a Ph.D. in educational or psychological measurement and statistics, educational psychology or a closely related field. A late stage A.B.D. will be considered. The successful candidates will have strong background in applying IRT and CTT to large-scale testing programs, proven ability to analyze and solve measurement problems in real testing environment, experience in designing, conducting, presenting, and submitting psychometric studies. Candidates are expected to have strong data analysis skills, work well with committees and colleagues in the office.
