




Early indications are that these goals were achieved in 2019, and so we thank the 2019 IMPS local organizers and past president Francis Tuerlinckx for the extra efforts involved in planning and coordinating this meeting.

As we look forward to IMPS 2020 at the University of Maryland, please be aware of our transition to a new abstract submission portal for the conference as well as a new website.
